Report of the Hony Secretary at the 36th Annual General Meeting held on January 10, 2015 at Jammu.

Dear Members,

I have great pleasure and indeed honour in welcoming you all to the 36th Annual General Meeting of the J&K Regional Branch of Indian Institute of Public Administration.

The 35th Annual General Meeting was held on January 4, 2014 at Jammu. Since then 6 meetings of the Executive Committee, 3 meetings of the Core Group have been held, besides 4 meetings were also held at Srinagar. I am grateful to the Patron, Chairman and Office Bearers and Executive Committee members of the IIPA for taking keen interest in achieving the objectives of the J&K Regional Branch of IIPA.

During the year 2014, following programmes were organised:-

1. **“Traffic Management in J&K” (January 16, 2014)**

An open house discussion on **“Traffic Management in J&K”** was organised on January 16, 2014 at Conference hall of IIPA. Jenab Choudhary Mohd Ramzan, Hon’ble Minister for CAPD and Transport, J&K was the Chief Guest and Shri Sourabh Bhagat, IAS, Transport Commissioner, J&K & Shri Muneer Ahmed Khan, IPS, IGP Traffic, J&K were the guests of Honour. Dr Anil Gupta, Joint Secretary of the Regional Branch conducted the program. Pawan Parihar SP Traffic coordinated the arrangements for the event.

2. **1st Ram Sahai Memorial Lecture on “GST: A Comprehensive Tax Reforms” (February 15, 2014)**

J&K Regional Branch organized 1st Shri Ram Sahai Memorial Lecture on **“GST: A Comprehensive Tax Reform”** in memory of Late Shri Ram Sahai, one of the founding members of the Regional Branch. Khawaja Bashir Ahmad, Advisor to Chairman, Empowered Committee of State Finance Ministers, delivered the key note address and Dr. S S Bloeria, Vice-Chancellor, Central University of Jammu presided over the function. Shri Rahul Sahai, Chairman, Sahai Group of Industries was the special Guest. The function was attended by members of the civil society, various Traders Associations, members from chamber of Commerce and Industries, IIPA members and prominent citizens.

3. **Seminar on “Safety of Women in Work Places” (March 12, 2014)**

A daylong seminar on **‘Safety of Women in Work Places’** was organized by the Regional Branch on 12th March 2014. The Seminar was attended by officials from 21 government departments, Corporate Sector and IIPA Members.

Prof Rekha Choudhary delivered the welcome address and Prof Poonam Dhawan in her key note address gave an overview of the issues related to work environment at the global level and the issues of sexual harassment. Dr Sarita Nayyar gave an elaborate exposition to the “Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace Act 2013”. In the 2nd session a panel discussion was held which was moderated by Prof Abha Chauhan, The panellists included Ms Nighat Shafi Pandit, Prof V.K.Kapoor and Ms Ellora Puri. The discussion was followed by a interactive session in which the delegates made comments and suggestions. The seminar was ended with a vote of thanks by Prof Alka Sharma, Director Seminars.

4. Interaction cum Presentation on “Criminal Justice System” (March 24, 2014) at Srinagar.

The Zonal Police headquarters Kashmir in collaboration with the Indian Institute of Public Administration, J&K Regional Branch and Central University of Kashmir, organized an interaction-cum-presentation on the **Criminal Justice System** on March 24, 2014. Dr. Robert Hanser, Director Institute of Law Enforcement, University of Louisiana, USA and Dr. Diana Bruns, from University of Missouri USA were the key resource persons.

On the occasion Prof. Mehraj-u-Din, Vice Chancellor of Central University of Kashmir was the Chief Guest and Muhammad Shafi Khan, Principal District and Sessions Judge Srinagar, presided over the function.

Joint Secretary IIPA, Kashmir Shri G.M.Andrabi coordinated the programme.

5. Workshop on “RTI Act-Expectations & Achievements” (April 5, 2014)

Indian Institute of Public Administration, J&K Regional Branch organised a Workshop on **“RTI Act-Expectations and Achievements”** in collaboration with State Information Commission for different stake holders including PIOs/Controlling Officers and Common Citizens.

In his inaugural address the Chief Information Commissioner Shri G.R.Sufi termed the RTI Act as revolutionary tool aimed at empowering the common citizens.

Dr S.K.Sharma, State Information Commissioner, traced the history and development of Right to Information as a fundamental right before coming in to existence of RTI Act. He also chaired a panel discussion in which eminent legal luminaries participated.

Dr Ashok Bhan, Chairman of the Regional Branch, in his welcome address outlined the details of the workshop and the expectations from the workshop.

The other speaker during the workshop included legal luminaries like Shri D.C.Raina, Former Advocate General, Shri Sheikh Shakeel Ahmad, Sr. Advocate, Shri B.L.Saraf former Session Judge and Prof V.K.Kapoor.

The workshop was attended by more than 190 PIOs/Controlling Officers from various government departments, Citizens and IIPA members.

The workshop was followed by lively discussion between the stake holders- citizens, PIOs/Controlling officers and the Commission. A number of clarifications were sought by the PIOs about the laws and the proceedings.

The proceedings of the workshop were conducted by Prof Alka Sharma, Director Seminar IIPA and Vote of thanks was presented by Hony. Secretary Shri J.B.S.Johar.

6. **Awareness Programme on “Efficient Delivery of Public Services through e-Governance” (May 1, 2014)**

Indian Institute of Public Administration, J&K Regional Branch organized a workshop-cum-seminar on efficient delivery of Public Services through e-Governance on March 1, 2014. Which was attended by administrators from various government departments, civil society, faculty members, research scholars, students from various Universities and members of IIPA.

In his opening remarks, Ashok Bhan, Chairperson IIPA J&K Regional Branch mentioned about the significance of e-Governance in taking administration to the doorsteps of a common citizen.

The keynote address was delivered by Amit Sharma, Special Secretary to Government, Animal/Sheep Husbandry Department. In his address he proposed various e-Governance solutions for various departments of J&K Government

It was followed by a case-study presentation by Dr Suparn Sharma, Director School of Business, SMVDU. Mr. D.S Bali, Addl. CEO, JKeGA, shared his experiences in introduction of e-Governance in J&K through IT Department and various e-Governance projects which are being successfully implemented in J&K.

The proceedings were conducting by Dr. Anil Gupta, Joint Secretary, IIPA J&K Regional Branch and the formal vote of thanks was presented by Sh. J B S Johar, Honorary Secretary, J&K Regional Branch.

7. **Lecture on “Security Governance – Challenges for the new Government” (May 12, 2014)**

The J&K Regional Branch organized a lecture titled “**Security Governance- challenges for the New Government**” by Prof. Gopalji Malviya, noted security analyst and currently Dean School of National Security Studies at the Central University of Jammu on May 12, 2014.

Prof Malviya strongly advocated for improving civil-military relations and revisiting of the procurement processes and modernization of defence forces.

Dr S. S. Bloeria, Vice Chancellor of the Central University of Jammu, who was the Chief Guest on the occasion, cautioned that Pakistan may test the waters by some provocative action to see the reflexes and response of the new Government and advocated strict vigil during the transition phase.

Earlier Dr Ashok Bhan, former DGP and Chairman of the J&K Regional Branch of IIPA introduced the guest speaker and the subject to set the tone for a very lively discussion. Shri JBS Johar, Hony Secretary, presented a vote of thanks and Dr. Anil Gupta conducted the proceedings of the seminar which was attended by officers of Army, PMFs, Police, academia and members of the IIPA and civil society.

8. **One day Training Programme on “Leadership: Carving the Path towards Organisational Effectiveness” (June 23, 2014)**

J&K Regional Branch organized one day training programme on “**Leadership: Carving the Path towards Organisational Effectiveness**” in collaboration with School of Business, Shri Mata Vaishno Devi University on June 23, 2014. The training programme was attended by 105 participants from 20 different government departments / private

sector organizations and members of IIPA. The training programme was organized with a focus to enlighten the role and relevance of effective leadership in organizational excellence.

Prof. Alka Sharma, from the Business School in her introductory address discussed various facets of leadership highlighting the characteristics of a good leader. Prof. S K Jain, Vice-Chancellor, SMVDU in his address focused on the Role of Leader in Team Building.

Dr. Suparn Sharma, Director, School of Business, SMVDU in his session discussed the various leadership styles and decision making.

Dr. Ashok Bhan, Chairman, IIPA (J&K) shared his own experiences while speaking on “Experience Driven Leadership”. He said that leader should take initiative and engineer change within an organization and innovate in public interest. He emphasized that leaders should give specific directions or set targets for ensuring timely and effective performance.

9. **Panel discussion on “Media and Electoral Verdict” (June 28, 2014)**

J&K Regional Branch organized a Panel discussion on “**Media and Electoral Verdict**” on June 28, 2014.

The panelists included Sh. Zafar Choudhary, Senior Journalist and Policy Analyst, Sh. Pradeep Dutta, Bureau Chief, Times Now, Prof Nirlape Kour, Govt. MAM College with Prof. Rekha Choudhary, ICSSR National fellow as the chairperson. The discussion was attended by prominent citizens of Jammu, members of Consumer Welfare Association, members of IIPA and scholars from University of Jammu.

Dr. Ashok Bhan, Chairman, IIPA (J&K) in his introductory remarks argued that media in India as the fourth pillar of democracy enjoys a credibility next only to Judiciary. Therefore the media having been placed at a high pedestal by the citizens must reciprocate this trust by objective reporting of news and views particularly during the important democratic exercise of elections.

Dr. Anil Gupta, Joint Secretary, IIPA (J&K) conducted the proceedings of the function.

10. **Panel discussion on “Minimizing Adjournments: Myth or Reality” (August 2, 2014)**

Indian Institute of Public Administration, J&K Regional Branch in collaboration with Criminologists Society of Jammu & Kashmir organized a Panel discussion on “**Minimizing Adjournments: Myth or Reality**” held on August 2, 2014.

“Hon’ble Justice (Retd) Shri J P Singh chaired the session and panelists included Sh. U K Jalali, Sr Advocate and Former Advocate General (J&K), noted academician Prof. V K Kapoor and Sh. B R Gupta, former Director Prosecution of J&K Police. The participants included members of legal fraternity, academia, IIPA and the civil society.

Dr. Ashok Bhan, Chairman, IIPA J&K Regional Branch introduced the panellists and the subject of discussion. Sh. Rameshwar Singh Jamwal, President, Criminologists Society of Jammu & Kashmir in his introductory note said that the justice delivery system is under tremendous strain and requires support of all organs of state and civil society

Minimizing adjournments in courts will remain a myth until procedural law is amended and made more stringent, strictly implemented and presiding Judges held accountable. Strikes and closure of court work for similar reasons must also be minimized as these

lead to avoidable adjournments and cause huge inconvenience to the people. These were some of the conclusions of a panel discussion.

Dr. Anil Gupta, Joint Secretary, IIPA J&K Regional Branch conducted the proceedings and presented the formal vote of thanks.

11. Seminar on “New Vistas in Tourism” (September 25, 2014)

Indian Institute of Public Administration, J&K Regional Branch in collaboration with Department of Tourism, J&K and Central University of Jammu organized a seminar on **“New Vistas in Tourism”** on September 25, 2014. The seminar was attended by various stakeholders of the tourism industry, officers of tourism development authorities, members of various tourism associations, faculty members and research scholars of various Universities, members of IIPA and civil society.

12. Lecture on the ‘Trends in Centre-State relations’ (October 4, 2014)

The J&K Regional Branch organised a lecture on the **‘Trends in Centre-state relations’** on October 4, 2014. The lecture was delivered by Prof Rekha Chowdhary, ICSSR National Fellow. Dr. Ashok Bhan, the Chairman of the Regional Branch presided over the lecture. This was a prelude conference on the theme chosen by the IIPA, New Delhi.

Prof Rekha Chowdhary in her lecture gave a brief introduction to the constitutional provisions related to Centre –State relations and discussed the reasons for a centralised federal structure as it was adopted in the Indian Constitution.

Dr. Ashok Bhan delivered the presidential address in which he highlighted the problems related to security and foreign policy issues due to the pressures coming from the state level leadership.

The programme was conducted ably by Dr. Komal Nagar, Joint Director Seminars. The vote of thanks was delivered by Prof Alka Sharma, Director Seminars. The lecture was organised under the supervision of Er JBS Johar, Hony Secretary.

13. One Day Training Program on “Ethics in Public Administration” (October 18, 2014)

The J&K Regional Branch organized a one day training program on “**Ethics in Public Administration**”. A total of 96 participants of 21 departments of J&K government attended the training program. The key theme areas of deliberations throughout the day long program included ‘Ethics in Public Administration’, ‘E-governance for efficiency and transparency’, ‘Right to Information and J&K Accountability Act’ and ‘Prevention of Corruption Act’, and a panel discussion on ‘Legitimacy and Accountability of State System-New Challenges’ along with exercise session for the participants.

Prof Neelu Rohmetra, Course Director presented the welcome address and introduced the theme of the training program and the speakers of the sessions to the participants. Dr. S S Bloeria, former Chief Secretary, in his inaugural address said that corruption is a top down approach and that moral authority is very a potent factor which can move the entire nation.

Dr Ashok Bhan, Chairman IIPA and Former DGP, J&K, while speaking at the program said that systems fail due to unethical behaviour and that purchaseability of criminal justice must go for good effect on polity.

In the session on e-governance for efficiency and transparency, Mr. D S Oberoi, Scientist, NIELIT, J&K highlighted the benefits of ICT for the reduction of corruption in our country. Prof Indu Aima, Formerly Professor IMPA conducted a hands on exercise session for the participants. In the post lunch session, Mr. Sheikh Shakeel, Sr. Advocate and Mr. D C Raina, Sr. Advocate and Former Advocate General, J&K high court spoke on RTI, J&K State Accountability Act and Prevention of Corruption Act respectively. The last session was a panel discussion in which Justice (Retd) O P Sharma, Dr. S K Sharma, Information Commissioner and Prof. Sunita Zalpuri Kaul, IMPA & RD, J&K highlighted key issues related to new challenges facing the system with respect to accountability of state systems.

The Training Programme was organised under the supervision of Er J.B.S Johar, Hony Secretary while Prof Neelu Rohmetra and Prof Alka Sharma were the Course Directors. Dr Komal Nagar, Joint Director Seminars coordinated the session and Dr Anil Gupta, Joint Secretary presented a formal vote of thanks.
